## OVERVIEW

Established by the Las Vegas City Council in 1997, the Las Vegas Medical District (LVMD) is now evolving as one of the most important economic development projects in Southern Nevada that will enhance and expand access to quality medical care, attract new, high-paying employers to the region and advance a higher quality of life.

The medical district is a collaborative effort between the city of Las Vegas and the downtown Las Vegas medical and health care community. The LVMD creates an environment that supports future and continued development of businesses and real property within the district.

## LVMD MISSION

By 2030, the Las Vegas Medical District will be the clinical care, research, wellness, education and training center of Southern Nevada and the premier academic medical district in the southwestern United States.

## LOCATION

Centrally located in downtown Las Vegas, LVMD encompasses approximately 684 acres with its 214 core acres bounded by Charleston Boulevard on the south, Rancho Drive on the west, Alta Drive on the north, and Martin L. King Boulevard on the east. Further development of the LVMD will also stimulate development near the city of Las Vegas' vital assets downtown like Fremont East, Symphony Park and 18B, the Las Vegas Arts District.

## CURRENTLY OPERATING WITHIN THE LVMD

- UMC - home to Nevada's only Level 1 Trauma Center, only Designated Pediatric Trauma Center, only Burn Care Center and only Center for Transplantation
- Children's Hospital of Nevada at UMC - the state's only hospital to be recognized and accepted as an associate member of the Children's Hospital Association
- Cleveland Clinic Lou Ruvo Center for Brain Health - offering treatment and ground breaking clinical trials and research for neurodegenerative diseases
- Valley Hospital Medical Center - acute care hospital founded in 1972 provides a comprehensive range of services that include: Emergency Care; Advanced Cardiovascular, Neurological and Surgical Programs; a certified Primary Stroke Center; Accredited Chest Pain Center; Wound & Hyperbaric Center; Gynecological Oncology and Adult Behavioral Health
- Horizon Specialty Hospital of Las Vegas – a long term acute care hospital
- Desert Radiology and Steinberg Diagnostic Medical Imaging – Southern Nevada's premier radiology and diagnostic imaging
- Southwest Medical – multi-specialty medical group
- Institutions of Higher Learning:
  - UNLV School of Medicine – first class of 60 students starts in 2017
  - UNLV School of Dental Medicine
  - Clinical Simulation Center of Las Vegas
  - Milan Institute
  - Touro University (Valley is the teaching hospital for Touro)
