Support the UNLV School of Nursing, UNLV Department of Physical Therapy, and UNLV's School of Allied Health Sciences education and training programs.

Promote the continuing development of the UNLV School of Dental Medicine education, training, research and care enterprise.

Promote the continuing development of NSHE's state-of-the-art Clinical Simulation Center of Las Vegas, which currently supports clinical training for the UNLV and Nevada State College (NSC) Schools of Nursing, the University of Nevada School of Medicine (UNSOM) and, ultimately, the UNLV School of Medicine.

Create and expand on excellence in health care, research, education and training opportunities located within LVMD.

Encourage master planning that is attractive to patients, employees, students, residents and new businesses and institutions, with attractively landscaped streets, parks and open spaces

Enhance connectivity to the region via mass transit and provide transit circulation within the LVMD.
